The First Wednesday buffet has been well attended lately. We have been complemented on the value pricing for this buffet. We still offer the lounge and dinner menu on this night, so if you are looking for a big steak or a light salad we can do it! We are eager and ready to serve.

The Board of Directors approved the use of credit cards for your guests at the January meeting. This will allow your guests to pay for their portion of the bill by Visa or Master Card.
